

# 5 COMMON ERRORS THAT CAN BREAK YOUR VACUUM CLEANER



## CLEANING WHEN OVERFILLED

Don't overwork your vacuum cleaner if it's full. Remember to empty it constantly, so you never lose vacuuming power.



## THINKING THAT IT'S BROKEN

If the vacuum cleaner doesn't turn on, check for anything stuck or a reset function; the fix might be that easy.



## TRYING TO CLEAN UP SPILLS

You've been lucky if you've gotten away with this. Liquids ruin the motor and can cause an electric shock!



## RUNNING OVER THE CORD

Let the vacuum cord out of the way!  
You can peel the cable open and  
make it unsafe to use.



## PICKING UP SMALL OBJECTS

Avoid messing up the motor. If you see  
a coin or a screw lying on the floor, pick  
it up with your hand.
